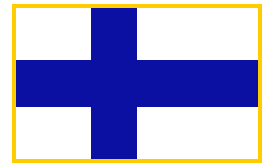
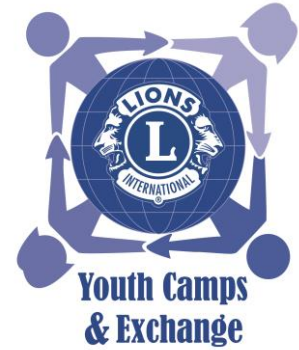

## Youth Camps in Finland 2019



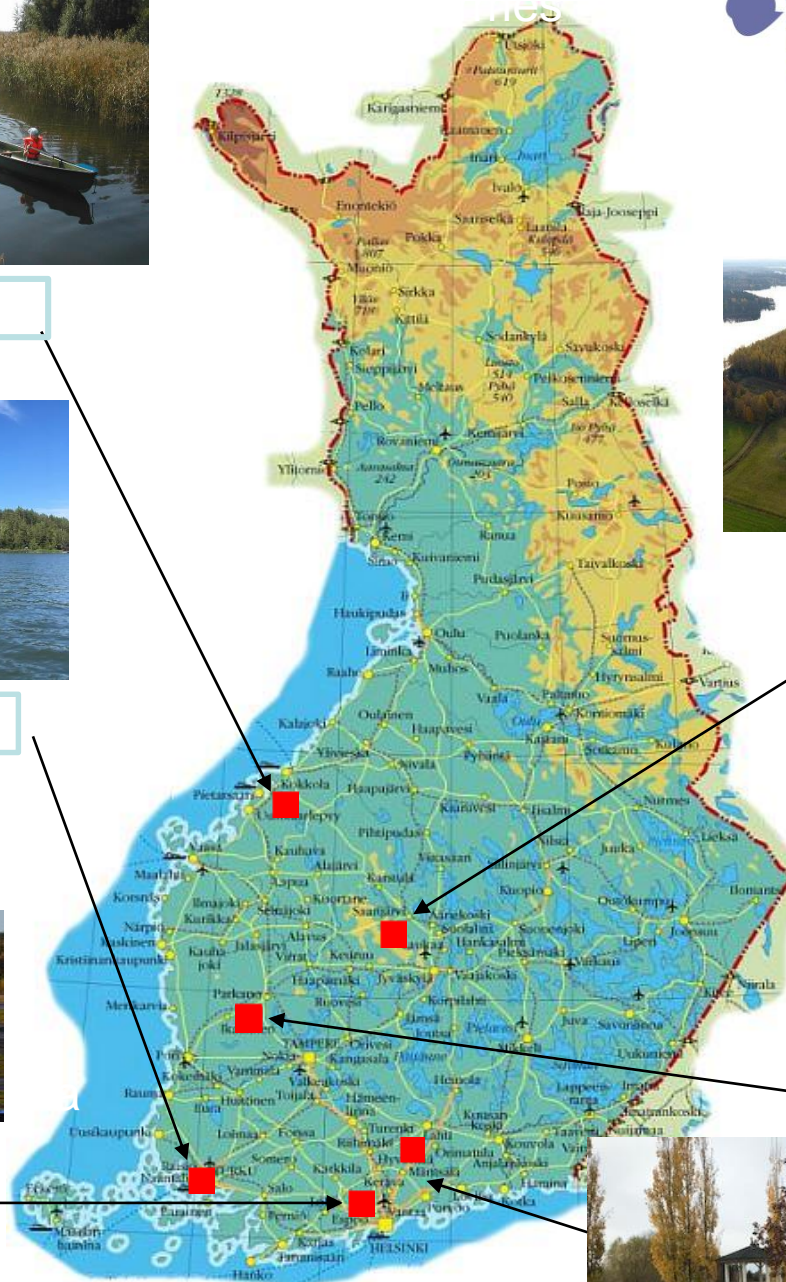
Kokkola 107 O

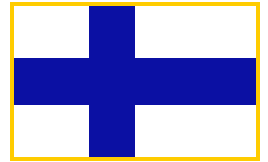

## Youth Camps in Finland 2019

Finnish lions (MD 107) invite foreign students, born 1.7.1998 - 30.6.2002 (17 - 21 years) to participate in the Youth Exchange (YE) program in Finland in summer 2019. The exchange period will consist of a family stay and a camp. The Finnish YE camps have places for 150 campers. The duration of the YE, including the camp, is about 3 weeks for European youths and about 4 weeks for non-Europeans. The family stay is mainly before the camp. Family hosting without a camp is available in special occasions.

The program is principally carried out on a reciprocal basis. The number of students to be sent to each destination shall be mutually agreed with YCED Ari Lindell or with the Finnish District YCEC in question by the end of November 2018.

**All applications from students wishing to apply for Finland must be dealt by local Lions Clubs. Applications shall be sent by a nominated District YCEC or the MD-YCEC of the country / state concerned to YCED Ari Lindell by the 15<sup>th</sup> of March 2019. Finnish camp organizations do not handle applications !**

The applications should be sent by E-mail separately to YCED Ari Lindell ([ari.lindell@lions.fi](mailto:ari.lindell@lions.fi)):

1. Application in Excel (editable)
2. The scanned last side with signatures
3. One or two photos of the applicant and family
4. Letter to the host family
5. Copy of passport/ID-card
6. EHIC card or similar

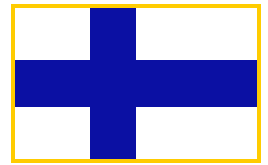

## 1. Lions Youth Camp-The Baltic Sea - Enjoy Unique Archipelago - Turku - 107A

August 1<sup>st</sup> - August 11<sup>th</sup> 2019

Males and females; age 17-21 (born 1.7.1998 - 30.6.2002); 30 campers

Camp Fee: None

**Camp theme and activities:** The Baltic Sea and Unique Archipelago. We will save our nature also to our children and young people. At the camp we will enjoy the unique clean sea, nature and wild forest. You may go fishing, picking berries and swim in natural waters and of course bathe in a Finnish Sauna! Together we shall make memories for the rest of our lives! Welcome to get unforgettable memories and new friends around the world! Come and experience Finland from different angles.

## 2. Lions Youth Camp-Discover the truth of Finnish nature - Parkano - 107E

August 1<sup>st</sup> - August 9<sup>th</sup> 2019

Males and females; aged 17 - 21 (born 1.7.1998 - 30.6.2002); 30 campers

Camp fee: 100 €

**Camp theme and activities:** The camp is in middle of Finnish nature in Vahojärvi camp centre at the city of Parkano. During the camp week we will visit and hike to many different places: Visiting and hiking at the Nature park of Seitsemien in Kuru. There are f.ex possible see Finnish forest reindeers.

All the camp tours take a daylight. It is possible sleep in a tent with 20 campers.

Every evening is possible to bath in the Finnish sauna and enjoy open fire telling stories and singing. Welcome to enjoy in the fantastic Finnish nature in Parkano!

## 3. Lions Youth Camp - The past meets the present - Uurainen - 107G

July 26<sup>th</sup> - August 4<sup>th</sup> 2019

Males and females; aged 16 - 21 (born 1.7.1998 - 30.6.2003); 30 campers

Camp fee: 150 €

**Camp theme and activities:** Come and experience today's life in the culture-historical milieu of the vicarage from the end of the nineteenth-century in Marjoniemi, which is located in Uurainen. The camp is held in beautiful landscapes, exploring the space for a variety of recreational activities.

Because of the camp environment, the camp is unsuitable for young people with animal allergies. Similarly, we can't provide a vegan diet.

## 4. Lions Youth Camp - Uusimaa - Mäntsälä - 107N

July 27<sup>th</sup> - August 4<sup>th</sup> 2019

Males and females; aged 17 - 21 (born 1.7.1998 - 30.6.2002); 30 campers

Camp fee: 150 €

**Camp theme and activities:** Feel the pure and authentic Finnish nature!

Make yourself at home in Saari manor in the middle of a typical Finnish landscape in Mäntsälä. You don't have to be an athletic or scout to apply to this camp but you need an open mind to try different kinds of activities you probably haven't tried before! No for animals allergies.

July 21<sup>st</sup> - July 28<sup>th</sup> 2019 Males and females; aged 17 - 21 (born 1.7.1998 - 30.6.2002);

30 campers. Camp fee: None

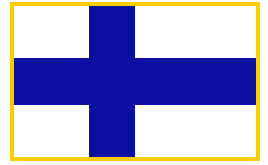
